VR Fish/MAA Delegate Report

#### 1. Recreational Fishing Initiative 2014-2018

Amount allocated \$16 million Developed by Fisheries Victoria and supported by the Victorian Government

- Developing new recreational fisheries by stocking trout cod, Macquarie perch, Australian bass and estuary perch into suitable waterways;
- Improving fish migration by installing fish ladders and removing instream barriers along the Loddon and Broken Rivers and Banimboola Creek;
- Improving access at Venus Bay, Port Welshpool and along the Rubicon, Nicholson and Campaspe rivers;
- Improving boat launching facilities at locations such as Gunbower Creek, Loddon River, Loch Sport, Lake Toolondo, Swan Hill, Murtoa and Peterborough;
- Installing fish cleaning tables at locations such as Eagle Point on the Mitchell River, Venus Bay and North Road boat ramp at Brighton;
- Conducting more public forums for recreational fishers and Fisheries Victoria to exchange ideas on ways to improve recreational fishing;
- Working with recreational and commercial fishers to implement measures to protect spawning fish stocks near river mouths;
- Increasing fisheries patrols on weekends and public holidays; and
- Undertaking research to support recreational fishing.
