### **Competition E3 Bemm River**

**Trip Captain's report** – Angling Committee: Peter Manning/George Green

In short, the wettest and windiest Bemm River trip on Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday started with a lovely morning, but around 10:30am wind blew up and then rain started, although not heavy; seals were seen in the river and the channel.

Sunday didn't improve, in fact the rain was heavier in the morning although it dropped after lunch; the wind was gusting constantly from the south to south west. Those who ventured out tried to find a sheltered spot in the river, or on the bank.

On Monday, there were many more fisherman and boats on the water, with lures/plastics in the river and channel, plus there were seals seen in the lake and in the channel.

George and Judy, and Alex and Serg all fished the river

Peter and Tom fished outside the river mouth and then in the channel

Mario and Michael fished the lake, mainly around the Mahoganies

Fish numbers were down in species until Monday. Only one fish reached a kilogram (generally down on big fish), and the males had largely spawned

- In addition, Tom Nadebaum caught a yellow eyed mullet weighing 0.725 kg which would have been a club record (as well as 2 luderick), however, being a bream-only competition, this fish did not count
