Members' Angling Reports (reports from previous Members Night):

1. Keysborough Angling Club fished Williamsons: 11 sent but only 6 fish were weighed in (and over 3 trips only 10 fish were weighed in).
2. There is talk of Fisheries reducing bag limits – members to investigate.
3. Alex fished Hastings for undersized fish including couta – it was generally “dead”.
4. Peter fished Hastings (water temp 11.5 degrees) for undersized flathead, but on the change of tide managed to pick up couta, snapper and flathead
5. George prospected Gunnamatta, reporting 4 fishers, with the best bag of 6 salmon on pilchard/popper to 8:30am. There were good holes and gutters, but quite a swell.

6. Trevor has 4 boat ramp passes to sell.

Trip Captain's report – S2-S3 Surf at Port Albert Beaches – George Green

Weather was great, and there were good reports in the week before of salmon up to 1.9 kg by Keysborough Angling Club. However, a trawler came through in the following days and took 2 semi-trailer loads. There were also many people camped at Reeves beach, although not many were actually fishing.

The Byrnes Road access to "Ormond Beach" was impassable in the last 200 metres, so no-one fished it.

The beaches looked good, but conditions flattened out on Sunday.

Some members took small salmon on lures, while others fished bait and poppers. It was hard to catch size fish. There were also lots of crabs.

Note that WillyWeather tides were incorrect for Woodside beach, and it may be better to simply use the tides forecast for Port Phillip Heads.

Trip Captain's report – S4 Surf at Gunnamatta – Peter Manning

Conditions were difficult, with big seas running up the beach and patches of weed. Some members left early because of the conditions.
